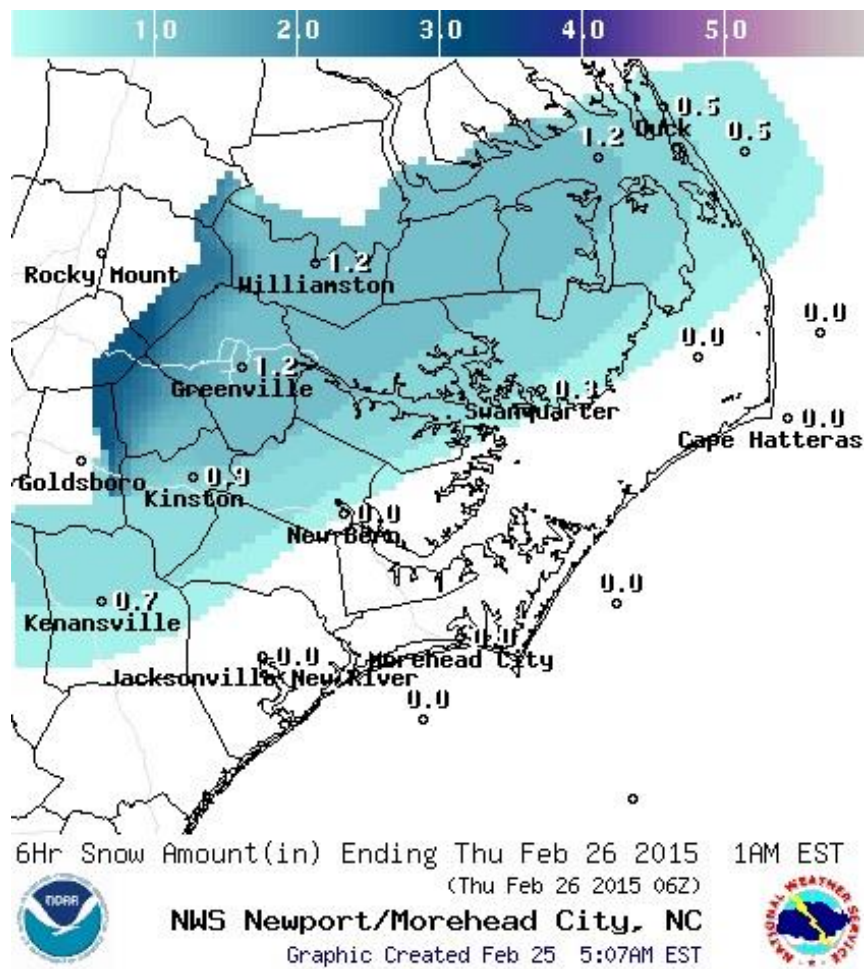

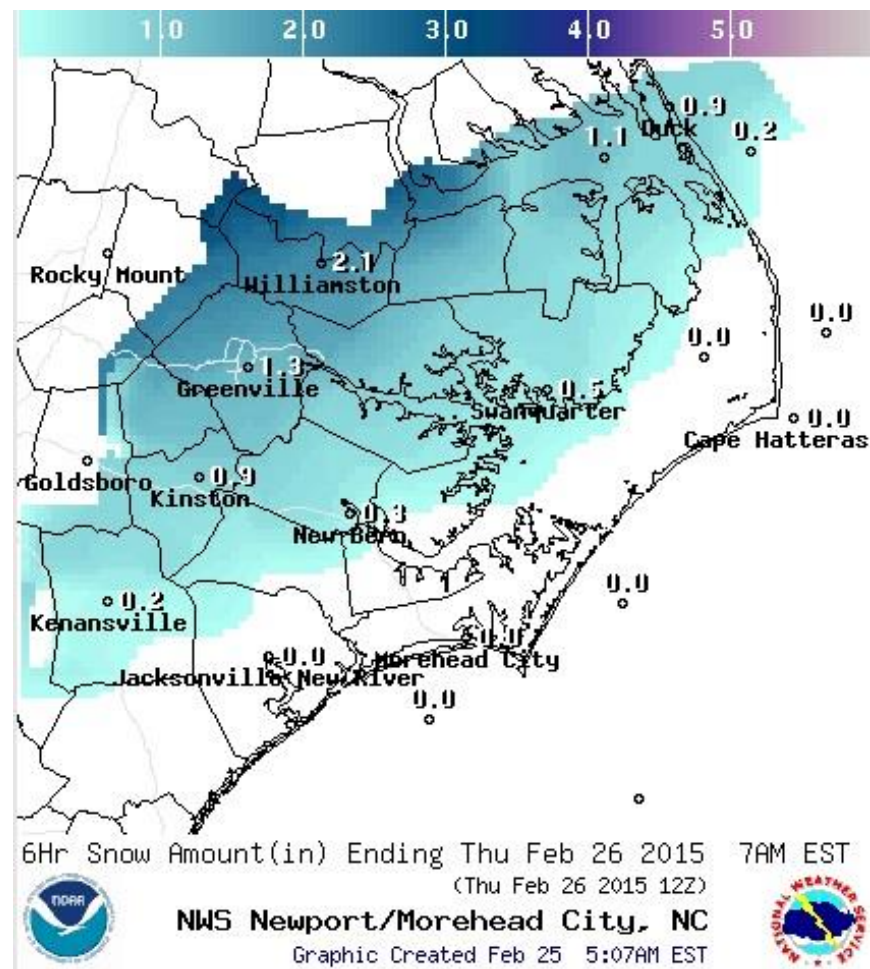
Tonight through Thursday

- **Winter Storm Watch**: all counties in eastern North Carolina.
- **Timing**: In effect from 7pm this evening to 7pm Thursday evening.
- **Impacts**: Another coastal low pressure system will impact the area tonight through Thursday. The event will begin as rain and transition to a wintry mix near the coast with all snow for inland counties. Highest snow accumulations are expected across Lenoir, Greene, Pitt, and Martin Counties late evening into Thursday morning.
- **Confidence Level**: Moderate.

NWS Newport Forecast Snow Totals

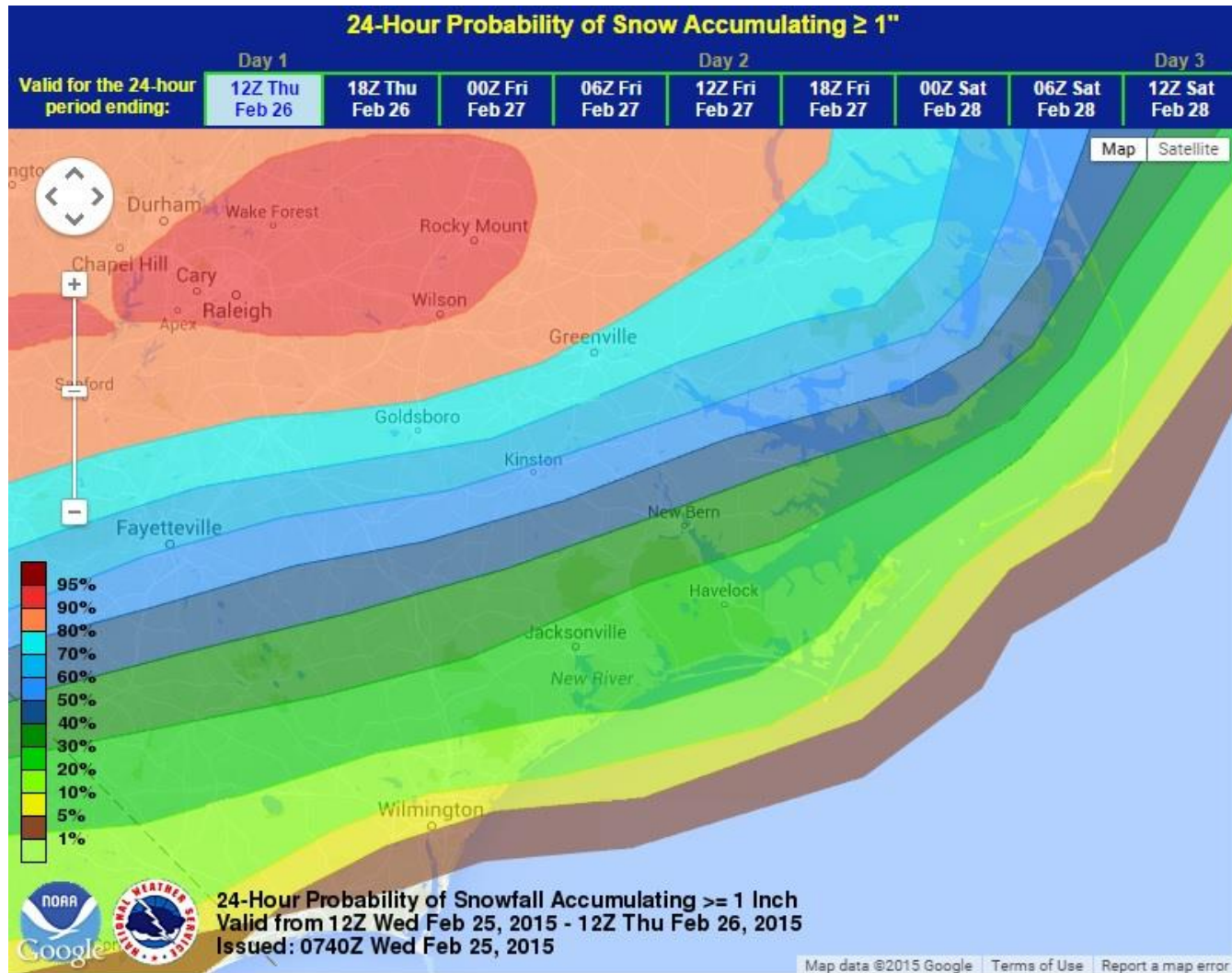


7pm this eve thru 1 am Thursday



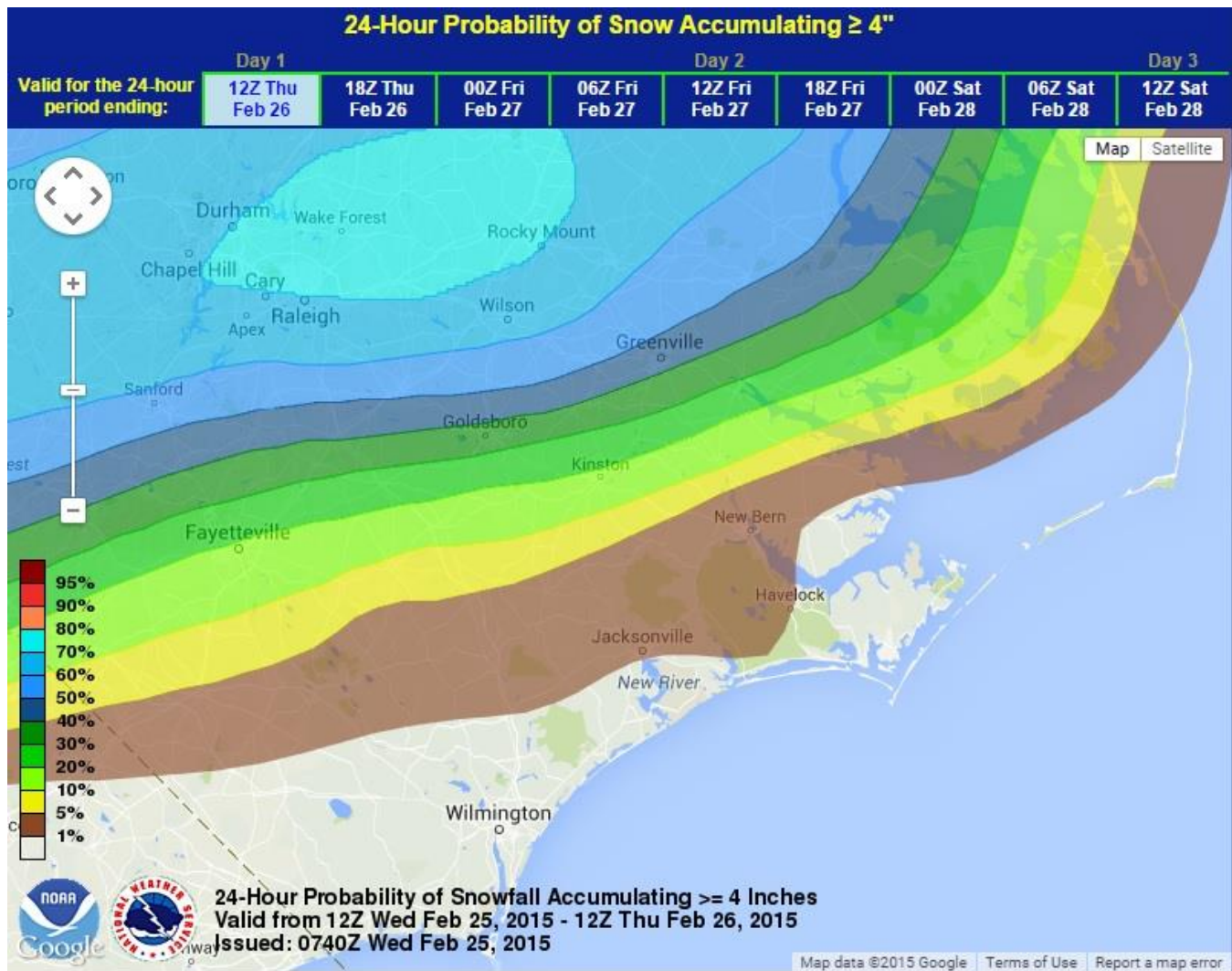
1 am-7 am Thursday

Snow Accumulation Probability



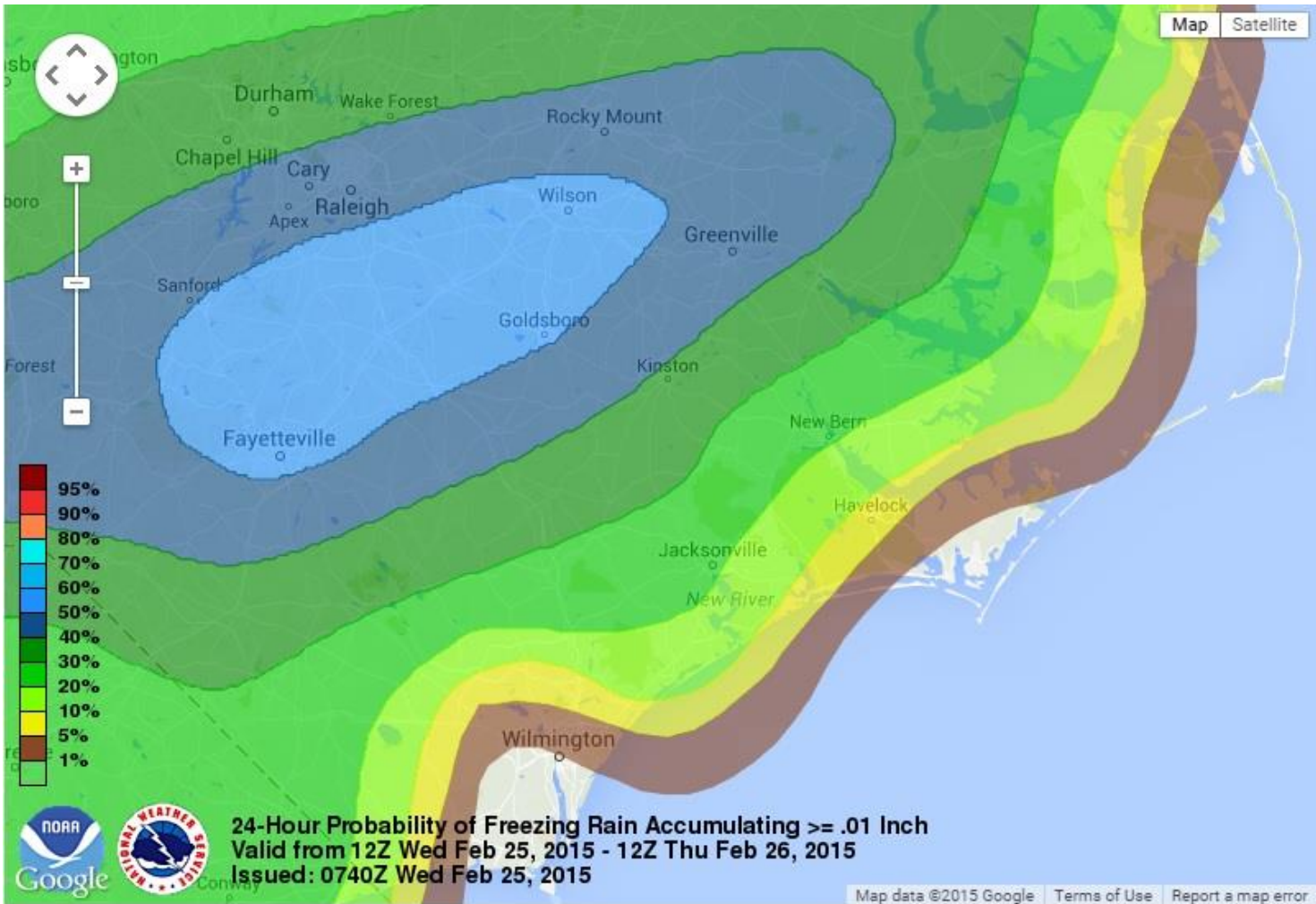
This graphic shows the 24 hour probability for 1 inch or more of snow Wednesday night through Thursday...note high values over northwest portion of eastern NC.
