










## **Timing of Severe Weather Threat**









## **Tornado Threat**










## **Damaging Wind Threat**










### **Rainfall Forecast for THR**









#### **General Weather Summary**

- > Hot temperatures are expected across the state today
  - o Portions of central and eastern NC will see temperatures over 95 °F this afternoon
- > Thunderstorms will develop this afternoon and move across the state through the evening
- > Conditions improve Friday clear skies and warm temperatures are forecast for the weekend

#### **Impact Weather Summary**

- > Severe thunderstorms are possible across the entire state today
  - o Main threats are damaging winds, large hail, and isolated tornadoes
  - o Severe weather is most likely to occur between 3PM and 11PM
