Resolution: Election Reform

Whereas: The confidence of our citizens in the conduct of elections is critical to preserving the republic; and

Whereas: Questions have been raised concerning states conducting questionable elections in 2020; and

Whereas: the gold standard for voting has traditionally been voting in person on election day; and

Whereas: Mail-in absentee ballots have historically presented opportunities for fraud; and

Whereas: North Carolina needs to have an election process that is above reproach;

Be It Resolved:

That all voters must present a valid photo ID; and

That voting in person on election day should be strongly encouraged; and

That an ongoing system to monitor and correct the voter rolls be implemented by each local jurisdiction and reported to the North Carolina Board of Election and to the State Legislature; and

That absentee ballots must be mailed through the USPS or dropped off at the Board of Elections office by the voter or a close relative.
